HolyLand 3d v2.5 Windows Vista/7/8 Compatibility Fix

The HolyLand 3d v2.5 CD relies on and ships with version 5.02 of the Skyline TerraExplorer 3d engine. This version has some known compatibility issues with certain versions of Windows Vista/7/8. Upgrading to the very latest publicly available TerraExplorer engine is not a solution as the latest version (v6.5) of the TerraExplorer 3D engine released by Skyline Software Systems breaks compatibility with the HolyLand 3D v2.5 and earlier.

If you are having trouble running v2.5 of the CD with your version of Windows, first make sure you have all the latest Windows updates installed. Running Windows update fixes the issues a lot of the time and is the preferable way to resolve the problem. If that fails and you still can't run the application, you can download an update from the Rohr Productions website by following these instructions:

- 1. Make sure you have installed the HolyLand 3D application from the CD and that your version of Windows has all the latest updates applied.
- 2. If the HolyLand 3D application still doesn't start correctly, download the update from http://www.rohrproductions.com/terraexplorer/TerraExplorerSetup.513.exe
- 3. Run the file by double-clicking it.
- 4. If a warning appears saying that the current version is newer, you must un-install the HolyLand 3D application as well as the TerraExplorer application using "Add-Remove Programs" in Windows. Once they are removed, you need to re-run the downloaded update.
- 5. Once they are removed, re-install the HolyLand 3D v2.5 from the CD and once that is complete, run the downloaded TerraExplorerSetup.513.exe update.
- 6. After running the update, follow the install wizard and wait for the program to finish installing.
- 7. After install is complete, you may run the HolyLand 3D application again.
